

American Maggie Privacy Policy

American Maggie knows that you care about how your personal information is used and shared, and we take your privacy seriously. Please read the following to learn more about our privacy policy. By visiting the American Maggie website, you are accepting the practices outlined in this Privacy Policy.

What Does This Privacy Policy Cover?

This Privacy Policy covers American Maggie's treatment of personal information that American Maggie gathers when you are on the American Maggie website and when you use American Maggie services.

What Personal Information About Users Does American Maggie Collect?

Our primary goal in collecting personal information is to provide you with a friendly, customized, and efficient experience. We only collect personal information that is relevant to the purpose of our website. We do not process this information in a way that is incompatible with the purpose for which it has been collected or subsequently authorized by you. We collect the following types of information from our users:

1. Information You Provide to Us:

We receive and store any information you enter on our website or provide to us in any other way. You can choose not to provide us with certain information, but then you may not be able to take advantage of many of our special features.

2. Automatic Information:

We receive and store certain types of information whenever you interact with us. American Maggie automatically receives and records certain "traffic data" on our server logs from your browser including your IP address, American Maggie cookie information, and the page you requested. American Maggie uses this traffic data to help diagnose problems with its servers, analyze trends and administer the website.

American Maggie may also add on any page display the total counts that page has been viewed. This includes member profile pages.

Social sharing of data: American Maggie may in the future allow other users to browse stories that you have voted on, or submitted. American Maggie may choose to post this data on other site features in the future.

Profile information: American Maggie does not currently allow other users to browse your full name, location, and instant messaging URL, within your member profile should you provide this optional information.

Syndication: American Maggie allows for the RSS syndication of all of its public content within the website.

Many companies offer programs that help you to visit websites anonymously. While American Maggie will not be able to provide you with a personalized experience if we cannot recognize you, we want you to be aware that these programs are available.

What About Cookies?

Cookies are alphanumeric identifiers that we transfer to your computer's hard drive through your Web browser to enable our systems to recognize your browser and tell us how and when pages in our website are visited and by how many people. American Maggie cookies do not collect personal information, and we do not combine information collected through cookies with other personal information to tell us who you are or what your screen name or email address is.

The "help" portion of the toolbar on the majority of browsers will direct you on how to prevent your browser from accepting new cookies, how to command the browser to tell you when you receive a new cookie, or how to fully disable cookies. We strongly recommend that you leave the cookies activated, however, because cookies enable you to take advantage of some of American Maggie's features.

Some of our business partners may use cookies on our website (for example, advertisers). However, we have no access to or control over these cookies.

Will American Maggie Share Any of the Information it Receives?

Information about our users is an integral part of our publication. We neither rent nor sell your personal information to anyone. We share your personal information only as described below.

Business Transfers: In some cases, we may choose to buy or sell assets. In these types of transactions, user information is typically one of the business assets that is transferred. Moreover, if American Maggie, or substantially all of its assets, were acquired, user information would be one of the assets that is transferred.

Protection of American Maggie and Others: We may release personal information when we believe in good faith that release is necessary to comply with that law; enforce or apply our conditions of use and other agreements; or protect the rights, property, or safety of American Maggie, our employees, our users, or others. This includes exchanging information with other companies and organizations for fraud protection and credit risk reduction.

With Your Consent: Except as set forth above, you will be notified when your personal information may be shared with third parties or used for a purpose incompatible with the purpose(s) for which it was originally collected, and you will be able to prevent the sharing of this information by opting out.

Is Information About Me Secure?

Your American Maggie account information is protected by a password for your privacy and security. You need to work to protect against unauthorized access to your password and to your computer by logging off once you have finished using a shared computer.

What Choices Do I Have?

As stated previously, you can always opt not to disclose information, but then you may be unable to use certain features on our website, such as posting new links.

You are able to add or update certain information on pages, such as those listed in the "What Personal Information About Users Does American Maggie Collect?" section above. When you update information, however, we often maintain a copy of the unrevised information in our records.

You may request deletion of your American Maggie account by sending an email to info@americanmaggie.com. This removes all of your past American Maggie usage from public view.

Please note, however, that if your browser does not accept cookies, you will not be able to take advantage of some of our attractive features.
